Cutting Instructions			
Background (Blue)			
Cut Strip Size	Length	Qty	Step/Block
3½	WOF(42")	5	Step 1 & 4C
9½	WOF(42")	2	Step 4 - A&B
Low Volume (4 Fat Quarters)			
Cut Strip Size	Length	Qty	Step/Block
3½	FQ 21"	18	Step1(4)Step 2(14)

Prints (7 Fat Quarters)			
Cut Strip Size	Length	Qty	Step/Block
3½	FQ 21"	22	Step 2 (7) Step 3(15)
2½	FQ 21"	13	Binding (Scrappy)
2 ea 2½ strips from each Fat Quarter 3			

Step 1 - 4 WOF Background Strips and 4 Low Volume FQ Strips - Make 4 Strip Sets

Cut into 18 each - 3½x9½ - you will have a few extra depending on the length of the FQ's

Step 2 - 14 LV - FQ Strips and 7 Print FQ Strips - Make 7 Strip Sets

Cut into 32 each 3½x9½ - you will have a few extra depending on the length of the FQ's

Step 3 - 15 each Print Strips - make 5 each Strip Sets

Cut into 24 each 3½x9½ - I ironed ½ to the center and ½ out, then mixed them up to nest seams when placing in rows

Step 4 - Background Strips

A.Cut 1 - 9½ inch BG strip into 3ea - 9½x9½" and 2ea 3½x9½"

B.Cut 1 - 9½ inch BG Strip into 6 ea - 6½x9½"

C.Cut - 3.5" Strip into 4 ea 3½x6½"

Fabric Requirements
1¼ Yards Background/Solid Fabric
4 - Low Volume Fat Quarters
7 - Print Fat Quarter

Note - 7 Fat Quarters is enough fabric but when I make again I think I will use 8 for a little more variety and will a little more for the scrap bin. Trudi

Finished Size - 39" x 69"

Make 2 rows- Row 1 and 9

Make 4 rows- Row 2,4,6, and 8

Make 3 rows- Row 2,4,6, and 8. Assemble center 9 patches first then add Background squares
